Benefits

- TIPS has the ability to manage all information with respect to traffic citations.
- With an internet connection in the courtroom, data can be entered in real-time.
- Data is housed on AOC servers with double redundancy. This means that if one server fails, the other will still be available.
- TIPS will allow courts to come into compliance with recent legislation requiring that all driving convictions be reported to DDS within 30 days.
- TIPS will decrease overhead costs by eliminating much of the paper and mailing expenses currently required to report to DDS.
- TIPS is offered at NO COST to your court.
- TIPS is completely web-based which means any software updates are done at the AOC.
- DDS will pay forty cents for each citation that is processed electronically.
